Exclusively built in Dressage in Silverado, the Shiloh II is one of Baywest Homes' newest designs and the reception it's had since opening in the spring has just been exceptional.

"People just love every aspect of it," says Baywest's Amanda Reynolds. "From the wide and welcoming open-to-shove entrance, to the fabulous gourmet kitchen, and the spaciousness of all the bedrooms, not just the master bedroom. It's a certified hit for us."

The 2,673-square-foot Shiloh II packs in all the fun style and functional practicality of a well-designed family home. The triple car tandem garage embodies the design's studious practicality, as it offers room for a family's future growth.

"We have the full range of buyers here, from singles and downsizers to young families, and they like that the Shiloh II's design takes into account future eventualities in their lives, like kids growing up and needing more space, including parking for their own car," Reynolds says.
